I would like to formally request a <b>Dyslexia screening</b> for my child

My child has demonstrated persistent difficulty with Reading and/or Writing that has been addressed with evaluation and treatment of other disorders without positive results, and impairment remains.
I understand I need to sign a consent form so the school can conduct the evaluation/screening. If I do not hear from you in three days I will call to set up a time to sign the consent form.
After screening is complete, and prior to attending a meeting to discuss the results with a team, I request I have a chance to review the result and ask any questions I have with the evaluator.
I understand that if the dyslexia screening conducted by the LEA indicates that a student has characteristics of dyslexia, the LEA shall provide the student with appropriate tiered dyslexia-specific intervention through its RTI2 framework and academic accommodations as appropriate, and also access to assistive technology.
